POINTS TO NOTE

- 1) Full Membership Subscription is inclusive of the following items:
- Basic Subscription This charge is set against the operating costs of the Synagogue.
- Congregational Assessment A percentage of the Synagogue's income which is paid over to Liberal Judaism who are representative of the constituent synagogues and their members. This includes payment for the Leo Baeck College – Centre for Jewish

Education

- **Jewish Joint Burial Society (JJBS)** Full details of burial/cremation and funeral schemes are supplied separately. Please note that new applications wishing to join the Synagogue after the age of 50 will be asked to pay an additional entry fee to the burial scheme. The amount varies in relation to the age at the time of joining. Non-Jewish partners of Full Members can be buried by the JJBS. Please speak to our Membership Secretary to arrange this or if you need more information about any aspect of the JJBS.
- **Voting Rights**. Only Full Members and Students are entitled to vote at General Meetings of the Synagogue and to be elected to the Council, or stand for election as an Honorary Officer.

- 2) Student Members/Friends/Newsletter Subscribers are not covered for any Funeral / Burial / Cremation Costs
- 3) Fees are billed on, and are payable from, the first day of April each year. If any member fails to pay their account within 6 months the Synagogue reserves the right to suspend or terminate membership. No suspension or termination will take place without prior notification to you.
